Our Mobile Outreach Service aims to improve the safety of women and their children in Western Australia's South West region.

Communicare is committed to take action to respond to and prevent violence against women, and support the national drive for social change, creating safety within our workplaces and our community. One of the ways we do this is through our Mobile Outreach Service.

WHAT IS THE MOBILE OUTREACH SERVICE?

Communicare Tuart House has launched a Mobile Outreach Service in the South West region. Mobile Outreach is available in the following areas:

- Busselton
- Augusta/Margaret River
- Boyup Brook
- Bridgetown/Greenbushes
- Manjimup
- Nannup

Our service aims to improve the safety of women and their children, who have experienced domestic violence, by providing support for:

- Family Violence Restraining Orders (FVRO)
- Safety planning
- Family and domestic violence information
- Advocacy, case management and referrals
- Free community education and information sessions

HOW CAN THE MOBILE OUTREACH SERVICE BE ACCESSED?

Access to our service can be by self-referral, referral by a supporting agency or referral from another Communicare service.
