Items we can accept	Items we cannot accept
	
New Toys for children aged 0-12 years with tags still on/still in original boxes	New or used bikes, skateboards or scooters, large toys, toy guns, knives or swords
New or gently used books suitable for children aged 0-12 years	Books that have water damage, cover damage or bent covers
Soft toys in good condition	Soft toys that are stained or worn
Plastic toys in good condition	Plastic toys with broken or missing parts
Wooden toys in good condition	Wooden toys that are splintering, stained or broken
Battery operated toys	Electronic toys
Board games and puzzles in good condition, with instructions and original packaging	Board games and puzzles with missing parts, broken boxes or missing instructions
Sporting equipment such as cricket bats, tennis racquets, soccer balls, footballs in good condition	Damaged or worn sporting equipment, pool toys
New clothes with tags on, for ages 0-12 years, including socks and hats	Used clothing, new or used underwear or swimwear
New beach towels	Used beach towels
New makeup, jewellery, skincare or nail polish, suitable for children and in original packaging	Used or opened makeup, skincare products or nail polish
New or used backpacks, handbags or toiletries bags in excellent condition	Worn or damaged bags, bags that have been labelled with writing
New craft or science activity kits	Opened/used craft or science activity kits
Lego in good condition	Lego that is broken
