



# FREMANTLE ROCKINGHAM FAMILY SUPPORT NETWORK

The Family Support Network (FSN) provides culturally safe support for families and young people at risk, helping them strengthen connections, build support networks, and thrive in their community.

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Communicare is the lead Agency for the Fremantle Rockingham Family Support Network (FSN) in collaboration with Langford Aboriginal Association and Karla Kuliny Aboriginal Corporation.

The FSN operates across the South West corridor of the Perth Metropolitan area with office locations in Fremantle and Rockingham. The FSN provides culturally appropriate support to families residing in the local government areas of Fremantle, Melville, Cockburn, Rockingham and Kwinana.

The Family Support Network is a partnership of community sector services and the Department of Communities, providing a common entry point to support services for families with complex needs and those most vulnerable to involvement with the child protection system.

Communicare, Langford Aboriginal Association and Karla Kuliny Aboriginal Corporation, formally partner with support services in the South West metro corridor to provide:

- Information, planning, and goal setting
- Parenting and family support
- Service coordination and advocacy
- Counselling and mental health support
- Family and domestic violence intervention
- Support for care leavers aged 18–25
